Audition Tour

Ballet Idaho Summer Intensive provides comprehensive training in classical ballet technique. Students will be graded by the directors into four levels on the first day of the Summer Intensive.

Exploring Sleeping Beauty: Students will study with Artistic Director, Peter Anastos and Balletmaster, Alex Ossadnik focusing on excerpts from the ballet classic Sleeping Beauty, culminating in a final performance on Friday, June 25th. Apprentices and Trainees for Ballet Idaho's 2010/2011 season will be selected during the two-week intensive.

Video

Auditions Video auditions are accepted by mail with a \$25 non-refundable audition fee payable to Ballet Idaho on or before May 31st. Please label video/DVD with the student name and full address. Neither videos nor DVDs will be returned. Video should be under five minutes.

Housing is available from a list of host families at a fee to be negotiated directly with the host family. Fees start at around \$375 per week and include housing, two meals per day and transport. REFUNDS Tuition refunds are available up to May 1st. No refunds are available after May 2nd. Registration fees and audition fees are non-refundable.
