Unless severe illness, injury, or serious family emergency absences are NOT ALLOWED. (Unless injury is severe, scholarship student will be expected to be in class to observe and take notes.

SCHOLARSHIP

Ballet Idaho will cover tuition set forth by the individuals' contract.

TERMINATION

If at any time the dancer does not exemplify proper Ballet Idaho code of conduct (as stated in the Handbook), or does not uphold this contract this agreement will be terminated. In this case, Ballet Idaho has the right to collect tuition for all past classes. Monies will be collected at a specific time.
